6. Summary Scope of Contract:

The objective of the consultancy is to provide technical support to the IA during the implementation of the BNTF 9 Project. The work must consider thematic areas such as gender and environmental assessments, and shall seek to integrate disaster mitigation measures into designs. Consulting firms will also be required to provide technical inspection of construction works.
